To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to advise you of the requirements of the Town of Lyman's Sewer Use Ordinance as they pertain to the discharge of Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) into the Town's wastewater collection system from all food service establishments (FSE).

These requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. The Annual Administrative and Inspection Fee.
2. Prohibited Discharges to the Town's collection system.
3. Sizing Requirements and construction standards for the grease interceptor.
4. The minimum mandatory cleaning schedule for all grease interceptors.

Attached, you will find a copy of Section 10-24 of the Town's Sewer Use Ordinance, a copy of the fee schedule as it pertains to the Pretreatment and FOG programs, and the required registration form.

The Registration Form, the Permitting Fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00), and the first year's operating fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) must be submitted to the Department within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this letter. If you own more than one FSE you will need to submit the information required in this paragraph for each FSE separately. The information must be submitted to the following address:

Failure to return the Registration Form and/or the permitting and operating fees may result in the discontinuation of sewer service to the FSE.
