

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LYMAN, SOUTH CAROLINA, AMENDING ARTICLE VI
OF THE TOWN OF LYMAN CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO PEDDLERS; AND
OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Town Council of Lyman, South Carolina (the "Council"), the governing body of the Town of Lyman, South Carolina (the "City"), as follows:

1) Amend Article VI of the Lyman Code of Ordinances as follows:

§8-179 Same- Application; registration information

Amending to remove and replace Paragraphs 1 – 8 with the following:

Permit application; information. Any person desiring to engage in the activity described in Section 8-176 (1) & (2) shall, before engaging in such activity, file an application for a permit with the chief of police. The application shall state the applicant's name, age, sex, race, business and residence addresses, and the name and address of the applicant's employer or sponsor. The application shall state the length of time for which the permit is requested, shall be in writing and shall have been sworn before a notary public for the state.

§8-180 Same-Investigation of applicant

Amending Section 8-180 to remove and replace with the following:

Issuance of permit. After the filing by the applicant, and if, upon due investigation of the application, the application is approved the chief of police shall issue to the applicant a permit authorizing the applicant to engage in the activity described in such application for the period of time set forth in such permit. Such permits shall be restricted to daylight hours only, and only Monday through Saturday.

§8-181 Same-Bond Required

Removing the entirety of this section


§8-195 Same-Application Fees

Adding Section 8-195 to include permit application fees as follows:

Permit application fees: Any person applying for a permit shall pay a fee of \$175.00 for residential rate and \$350.00 for non-residential rate.

All orders, ordinances, resolutions, and parts thereof in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon second reading approval of the Town Council.
